The Maine State Library has the equipment for scanning, and I will be travelling down to Augusta one day this month to learn how to use the equipment and to figure out the scope of our project. Once we have some idea of how much time will be needed to digitize the whole collection, we will either be

looking for volunteers to help do the scanning or for some sponsors to fund a temp worker who could come in and do the scanning for us. If you have an interest in getting this piece of Rangeley's history online and available to the general public, as well as some time or money to put into this project, please let me know. Together we can make this project a reality!
