AnnualCreditReport.com is the only authorized source under federal law that provides free credit reports from the three major national credit reporting companies - Equifax, Experian, and TransUnion. If you would like more information, stop by the library and pick up a brochure about what mistakes to look for in your credit report as well as advice about what to do if you find a mistake.
