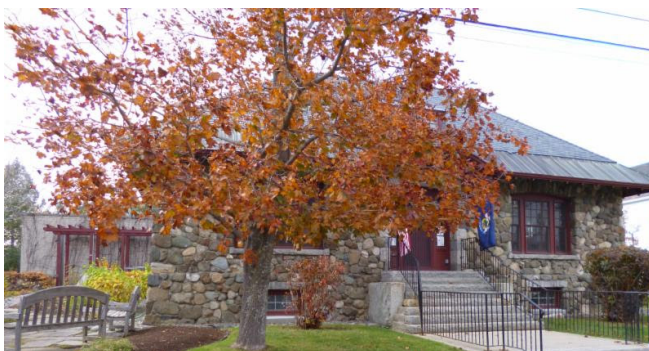




## RANGELEY PUBLIC LIBRARY October 2021 Newsletter

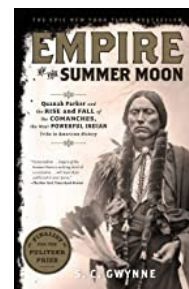
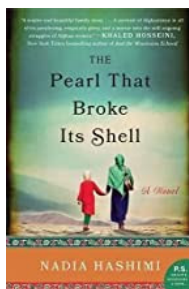
