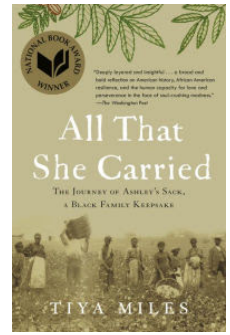
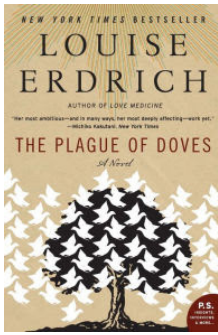
Summer Reading Program 2022

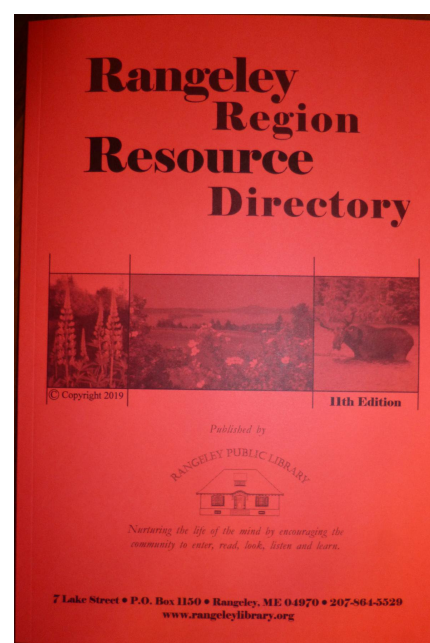
FUNDRAISING

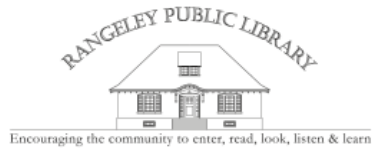
